OPERATING AND PLACE OF ASSEMBLY PERMITS

Effective January 1st, 2007 the New York State Department of State Codes Division passed a law requiring Operating permits for various operations. Some examples are storage/use flammable and combustible liquids, welding and cutting, motor vehicle repair garages, commercial cooking equipment, hazardous materials etc.

Places of Assembly of 50 or more persons are also required to have permits.

Title 19 of the New York Code, Rules and regulations Section 1203, (19NYCRR1203) requires the local Towns, Cities and Villages to pass local laws to require these permits, establish fees and perform annual inspections
